It is all about rescue and resettlement of runaway, missing, abducted and abandoned children majorly focusing at railway stations. Due efforts are made to trace the family address of the children. Then children are either reunited with their families or put on institutional care with appropriate involvement of government's Juvenile Justice System.

During the process of rescuing the children, SOCH identified a special group of children living in slums or streets who were getting involved in petty criminal activities or begging or addictions as they were not getting proper guidance from their family. SOCH categorized them into

Category	Given Facility
Hard Behavior Family Connected	3 weeks residential camp
Street Connected children	4 weeks residential camp.
Children who had dropped out of school and not completed the basic education	12 weeks Edu-Bridge Camp.

Taking all such conditions into consideration SOCH conceptualized Project "Punarjivan"

Project "Pankh" was conceptualized and initiated in 2015. It works for mainstreaming the youths from Child Care Institutions (CCIs) and communities having a difficult family background starting from the age of 14 years.

We have counselled more than 1000 youths and 250 young mass have enrolled themselves in various trainings.

- » To encourage foster parenting and alternative care for children in need of care and protection.
- » To develop child centric community through awareness camp and necessary support.
- » To conduct and participate in studies, surveys, seminars and work shop connected with children's issues.
